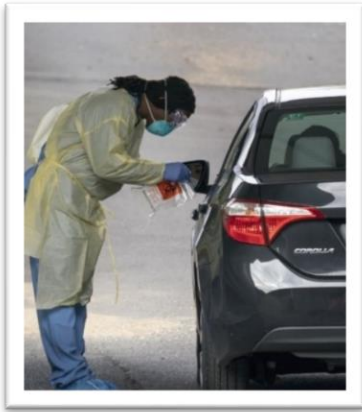

- PeaceHealth is partnering with the NAACP, LULAC and other local organizations to offer free and safe drive-thru testing to our Black and Latino community members in Vancouver, WA. Testing will not be available for children.
- To limit COVID-19 exposure among the community and clinical volunteers, community members being tested must remain in their cars throughout the event. A maximum of 4 adults per vehicle may be tested. Each adult must be seated next to a separate car window for test specimen collection safety.
- The free COVID-19 test will include a nasal swab specimen collected by PeaceHealth clinical volunteers. All participants will also receive a cloth facemask, hand sanitizer, food box and connections to community resources.
- Test results will be available 72 hours after the event via phone.
