So, what is a Dislocated Worker?

There are many ways you can qualify as a Dislocated Worker. But one of the most common ways is being terminated or laid off.



Self-employed workers can be Dislocated too due to general economic conditions or a natural disaster!

Losing the income of a family member or being the spouse of a member of the Armed Forces on deployment may also qualify you.



So does being discharged or released from military service!

Military spouses may qualify as well if they've lost their job due to relocation or are finding themselves underemployed or unemployed.



Dislocated Workers may be eligible for job training in an in-demand career, as well as support services like interview clothes, childcare subsidies, tools, work clothes, and more!
