Program Funding

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for program year 2022-2023 are provided as follows (Note: this includes carry forward funding from prior program years, as applicable):

- The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult and Dislocated Worker Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor/Employment and Training Administration as part of an award totaling \$949,340.00, with \$0 (0%) state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
- The National Dislocated Worker Opioid Recovery program (to address the Opioid Crisis) is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling (100%) \$614,525.00 with \$0 (0%) in state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
- The Economic Security for All (Thrive) agreement is supported by U.S Department of Labor/Employment and Training Administration as part of an award totaling (46.89%) \$443,494 with \$502,263 (53.11%) in state, local and/or non-governmental funds for an overall total of (100%) \$945,757.
